Manual Drain with Drain Bag

- 1. Spray work table with methylated spirit (1 part methylated spirit mixed to 4 parts of water).
- 2. Dry work table with paper towel.
- 3. Remove drain bag from outer pouch and place on top of work table.
- 4. Place minicap and hexol on top of work table as well.
- 5. Take catheter out and secure clothing away from catheter.



6. Complete a 3 minute handwash.

- Use non-touch connection technique to connect yourself by:
 - a. Holding catheter and bag lines on opposite hands.
 - b. Carefully remove caps then connect.
- 8. Close the blue clamp.
- 9. Place empty bag on the floor. Ensure clear part of the drain bag is facing up.
- 10. Open the white valve on catheter.

**Do not twist the light blue part of catheter.

- 11. Make sure catheter is draining fluid out.
 - a. Check the following:
 - Lines must not pull from the exit site
 - Catheter and lines are not kinked
- 12. You can sit down.
- 13. If draining stopped, close clamp on drain line.
- 14. Close white valve on catheter until it "clicked".**Do not twist the light blue part of catheter.

15. Stand up and open minicap packet.

16. Wash hands with hexol.

- 17. Disconnect bag line from catheter using nontouch technique.
- 18. Cover end of catheter with new minicap.
- 19. Secure your catheter in place with tape.
- 20. Weigh your drain bag and record volume in your book. **Calculate your UF.
- 21. Check the clarity of your drain fluid.
- 22. Discard drain fluid down the toilet or shower drain.
- 23. Throw empty bags in garbage.
