APD DISCONNECTION WITH OPTICAP STEP BY STEP for Relatives:

*Frequent disconnection from the machine whilst patient is on dialysis is highly discouraged due to increased PD catheter exposure increasing the risk of contamination and/or infection.

**Disconnections are only to be done for urgent toilet breaks. It is advised for patients to use the toilet before starting dialysis.

***If a patient needs more than 2 disconnections every time whilst on dialysis, please contact the PD unit.

- Press the red (STOP) button.
 If possible to wait, please disconnect whilst on DWELL phase.
- 2. Clamp the patient line.
- 3. Close the white valve on the catheter extension set.
- 4. Open Opticap packet.
- 5. Wash hands with antibacterial hand gel/lotion thoroughly. Wait for hands to dry.
- 6. Separate the minicap from the Opticap. Leaving both inside the opened packet.
- 7. Disconnect patient line using non-touch disconnection technique.
- 8. Place patient line back on the blue line organiser.
- 9. Apply the new minicap on catheter using non-touch technique.

- 10. Apply Opticap on the end of the patient line using non-touch connection technique.
- 11. Secure the PD catheter in place with tape.
- 12. Once patient returns- expose the catheter and keep away from clothing.
- 13. Have a 3 minute hand wash.
- 14. Remove the Opticap from the patient line and remove the minicap from the catheter.
- 15. Use non-touch connection technique to connect patient connect the catheter to the patient line.
- 16. Open the white valve on the catheter extension set.
- 17. Open the clamp on patient line.
- 18. Press GO (green button) to continue dialysis.
