

Polycystic Kidney Disease accounts for 1 in 10 people on dialysis and 1 in 8 kidney transplants in Australia. Right now, about 2000 people in Australia and New Zealand are living with kidney failure due to PKD. The estimated cost to the community is >\$80 million per year.

PKD accounts for 6% of all people diagnosed with kidney failure and affects people regardless of sex, age, race or ethnic origin.
