

# VMC Process

## 6mth f/u

1. At 6mths pathology reviewed by CNC and entered onto access and excel spreadsheet, email sent to nephrologist outlining results and informing of next F: F appointment.
2. If patient has a 5year KFRE>3% or a decrease of eGFR by more than 25% or 15ml/min then refer back to nephrologist for management plan. Letter to GP and patient outlining management plan.

## 12mth f/u

1. At 12mths pathology reviewed by CNC and entered onto access and excel spreadsheet, email sent to nephrologist outlining results, letter sent to GP and patient. If stable continue VMC for another 12mths.
2. If patient has a 5year KFRE>3% or a decrease of eGFR by more than 25% or 15ml/min then refer back to nephrologist for management plan. Letter to GP and patient outlining new management plan.

***If patient has 5year KFRE <3% and stable eGFR for 2 consecutive years on VMC then suggest discharge back to GP***

## Missed Pathology

1. Patient will be sent a pathology form (bicarb, urea, creat, eGFR, albumin, Ca, PO4, Hb and urine ACR) along with a letter. GP will also be sent a letter and nephrologist notified. Pathology will be followed up in 2 weeks from date letter sent.
2. If patient still has no pathology nephrologist notified for further management plan.
